TITLE: LEARNING DISABILITIES TEACHER – CONSULTANT

QUALIFICATIONS: New Jersey Teacher Certificate and New Jersey Learning disabilities Certification.

REPORTS TO: Superintendent of Schools, Principal, and chairperson of the Child Study Team.

TERM: 10 Months plus five days before and five days after teachers leave.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- 1. Cooperate with other members of the Child Study Team to diagnosis the referred child's special learning difficulties in terms of physiological, environmental, academic and psychological disabilities.
- 2. Advise the instructor of the Child's strengths and weaknesses and aid the instructor in the skills needed to work with the child to bring about desired changes in the child's learning performance.
- 3. Consult with the Principal, parents and others who are directly related to children identified as handicapped.
- 4. Serve as a resource person to the classroom teacher and help in the adaptation of instructional materials and resources to the particular needs of pupils.
- 5. Perform many other duties as may be required by the Superintendent, Principal, and the chairperson of the Child Study Team.
- 6. Sign in/out of each school building that you may be assigned to on a daily basis.
 - 7. To complete case manager duties.
 - 8. Finalize individual reports.
 - 9. Process referral within 90 days of the date on the Evaluation Plan.
 - 10. Report for duty the same time as teachers.
 - 11. Participate in professional activities at the County and State Levels.
 - 12. Act as a liaison between Child Study Team and other School personnel.
