TITLE: SCHOOL NURSE

QUALIFICATIONS: To be eligible for the position of School Nurse, a candidate shall be licensed as a registered nurse and have earned a degree in health education.

REPORTS TO: Superintendent of Schools and Principal.

TERM: 10 Months

REPONSIBILITIES: The Nurse shall:

- A. Assist in the conduct of medical and dental examinations, conduct vision and take height and weight measurements.
- B. Provide for emergency care of accidents and illness at school by developing procedure, instruction staff on first aid care and providing for adequate first aid supplies; she shall report all such accidents promptly.
- C. Carry out state requirements for communicable disease control and the exclusion and readmission of pupils for reasons of health.
- D. Confer with the Child Study Team on the identification, classification and placement of exceptional children.
- E. Maintain an accurate and orderly health record for each pupil.
- F. Cooperate with community agencies in providing health services for the school community.
- G. Participate in a program of health instruction and information dissemination by:
- 1. Teaching health education in the classroom and serving as a resource person to other staff members in matters of health education.
- 2. Assisting in the development of health curriculum and the selection of health education materials.
- 3. Assisting with in-service health education workshops.
- H. Supply teachers with specific health information on their students as they may require teaching thoroughly and efficiently.
- I. Assist in setting standards and developing procedures for school sanitation and safety.
- J. Communicate with parents as necessary to work toward the good health of students.
- K. Conducting yearly screenings for scoliosis on all pupils 10 years of age through 18 years of age pursuant to NJSA 18A:40-4.3.
- L. Annually conducting audiometric screening in grades preschool through 4, 6, 8 and 10 pursuant to NJSA 18A:40-4 and NJAC 6:29-5.2 c.
- M. Perform such other duties as required by the Superintendent and Principal.
