TITLE: SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST

QUALIFICATIONS: New Jersey Teaching Certificate and New Jersey School Psychologist Certification.

REPORTS TO: Superintendent of Schools, Principal and Chairperson of the Child Study Team.

TERM: 10 Months plus 5 days before and 5 days after teachers leave.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- 1. Participate in the planning, development and execution of a psychological services program. Cooperate with other members of the Child Study Team to diagnosis the referred Childs special learning difficulties in terms of physiological environmental, academic and psychological disabilities.
 - 2. Assist in the counseling of students where necessary.
- 3. Make recommendations and referrals to extra-school agencies and resources.
- 4. Act as consultant to the principal and staff regarding measurements, testing and evaluation.
 - 5. Participate in in-service programs for staff.
 - 6. Act as liaison between the Child Study Team and other school personnel.
 - 7. Finalize individual reports.
 - 8. Process referrals within 90 days of date on the evaluation Plan.
 - 9. Report for duty the same time as teachers.
- 10. Perform such other duties as required by the Superintendent of Schools, Principal and Chairperson of the Child Study Team.
 - 11. Sign in/out of each building you are assigned to on a daily basis.
 - 12. To complete case manager duties.
